Catherine Shaker MS/CCC-SLP, BCS-S is a Pediatric Speech-Language Pathologist with over 44 years' experience with neonates, medically fragile infants, and children through school age with complex needs across the continuum of pediatric settings. An ASHA Board Certified Specialist in Swallowing and Swallowing Disorders, Ms. Shaker has worked full-time in large Level III and IV NICUs for over 36 years and currently works at Advent Health for Children in Orlando. She has published several manuscripts on NICU intervention and co-authored The Early Feeding Skills Assessment Tool with Dr. Suzanne Thoyre. Ms. Shaker received the Pioneer Award from NANT (The National Association of Neonatal Therapists) and is a recognized leader in NICU practice and supporting EI clinicians following NICU graduates. She provides swallow studies for infants and children, is NDT trained, and an invited lecturer internationally and nationally for therapists, nurses, and physicians.
